### ***Summary***

In June 2023, the board of the Paula Salomon-Lindberg Foundation was completely taken by surprise by the sudden death of its treasurer Stefan Pinkus. Stefan joined the board in 2008 and has been treasurer since. Not only that we miss him as a kind and gentle person, his knowledge and skills are also sorely missed. A permanent replacement is still being sought.

Furthermore, 2023 was characterized by an absence of both applications and awarded subsidies and hardly any costs were incurred. For details see the attached financial statement 2023.

### ***Policy***

The policy of the board is aimed at granting financial support to members of the Progressive Jewish Congregations in the Netherlands, in particular to those of the LIG Amsterdam. This in connection to studies or courses for the purpose of being able to lead synagogue services, such as shaliach tsibur (cantor) or any other activities directly or indirectly related thereto, all in the widest sense.

To fund this policy the capital is invested safely and subsidies are only granted to the extent that these can be met from the (net)income of the fund, thereby taking into account – as far as possible- the effect of inflation.

### ***Financial Statement 2023***

According to the financial statement provided by the –temporary- treasurer, the capital of the fund has slightly reduced in 2023 from € 124.236 to € 123.932. At the close of 2023 a surplus of € 1991,03 was booked.
